We highlight the budget proposals for the year 2008 - 09 presented by the Honourable Minister of Finance and Development Planning, Mr. Baledzi Gaolathe. Presently, the budget is only a draft and will have to be approved by the National Assembly.

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Highlights in English

Budget Theme- Accelerating Achievement of Vision 2016 through NDP 10

Highlights

- Designed to achieve the goals of Vision 2016, including trebling of Botswana's real per capita income between 1996 to 2016.
- Free Trade Area among SADC countries to be launched in August 2008 to allow free movement of goods and services produced within the region.
- Short, medium and long term power supply strategies are being implemented to ensure that Botswana has sufficient power.
- Sovereign Credit rating "A" being maintained at the same level for 7 continuous years.
- Investment trust fund to be created as a vehicle for citizen empowerment.
- Botswana's export of beef to the EU will have no duty or quota for another year.
- Government to lease all its camp sites in protected areas to citizen entrepreneurs only.
- Beneficiation projects are well on course – diamond cutting, refining etc.
- Government continues to support the development of capital market with regular bond issuance program.
- Financial Reporting Bill is expected to be tabled in the Parliament during July 2008.
- Motor Vehicle Fund to cover all victims.
- Export development plan to be developed by BEDIA. LEA to train more than 1000 entrepreneurs during current year.
- Significant allocations to the Botswana Police Force, BDF etc to improve national security.
- Broadband expansion project to be completed in 2008.
- Information and Communication Technology innovation hub construction to commence in 2008.
- Comprehensive review of tax regime will be undertaken in the next financial year.
- Revision in public sector salaries to be announced later.
- Reduction of HIV prevalence among pregnant women.

Statistical highlights

- GDP forecasts for the 2008/2009 financial year is P83.25 billion in current prices.
- Forex reserves of P59.8 billion as at November 2007 representing 28 months cover of imports.
- Inflation has reduced from 11.6% during 2006 to 7.1% during 2007.
- Budget surplus in the last two years.
- Estimated balanced budget for 2008/2009.


Ditsela
